PCC's London Study Abroad Program offers an opportunity for students to earn transferable college credit during their studies in London during the spring term. PCC collaborates with the five other community colleges of the Oregon International Education Consortium (OIEC) and in association with the American Institute for Foreign Studies (AIFS) to administer the program. Approximately 15-30 students, along with two OIEC faculty members participate in this program every spring term. ### **\*Payment Deadlines\***

#### **All Applicants:**

**December 7, 2011** - Application fee of \$450 due (\$50 non-refundable).

#### **\*Financial Aid students:**

**February 1st- \$600 program reservation deposit, optional trip fees (airfare, fuel charges, Scotland tour balance, insurance upgrades) PLUS any remaining balance *not covered by financial aid* due. \* IMPORTANT!!!** Because Financial Aid is not disbursed until the term starts, any study abroad deposits and payments due prior to the start of the Spring Term are the responsibility of the student. PCC tuition and any program fee balance covered by financial aid is due upon dispersal of financial aid in March/April.

#### **\* Students not receiving financial aid:**

**February 1st- \$6075 balance of program fee, plus damage deposit (\$250), plus any optional trip fees (airfare, appx. fuel charge, Scotland tour balance, insurance upgrades) due.**

**After February 1st – No refunds!** Student is fully responsible for all or remaining program fee.
