Registration Confirmation

Confirmation of class registration is assumed once you register. Students registering 12 days before the term begins and who did NOT use MyPCC to register, will receive a mailed copy of their registration confirmation. **If you have not received a registration confirmation by the first week of class, you may call the registration helpline at 503-788-6266 to request one. This helpline is staffed Monday through Friday from 9am to 4pm.** Students who register through MyPCC receive registration confirmation online.

Dropping a Class

Please note that if you register for a class and do not attend, you are obligated to call and cancel before the day the class meets. If you do not, the College will bill you for the tuition.

Let PCC help keep your electrical training current and advance your career! Our classes offer the latest training in the electrical profession. Each course meets the requirements of the Oregon State Electrical Board for continuing education for license renewal. These classes can also be used to meet the Washington State requirements through the WA/OR reciprocity agreement. A Course Completion Award for eight hours of continuing education will be issued by the instructor at the end of each Saturday workshop to students who have proof of registration. Attendance rosters for all classes will be sent to the state for certification purposes. Please note that the electrician's license renewal fee does not include the cost of the classes listed in this brochure.
