

CAREER PATHWAYS TRAINING

Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Installation



Career Technical Pathway

This pathway is designed for students pursuing entry-level work as installers of HVAC systems. The target wage for entry-level HVAC positions in Oregon is \$11 to \$20 per hour. Students complete the pathway in one term and earn 14 credits.

Skills gained in this pathway can open the door to various jobs in the HVAC service industry and serve as solid preparation for the PCC Facilities Maintenance Technology Program or Apprenticeship and Trades programs.

Training Format

Classes are held Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Features

- Students earn 14 college credits that may be applicable to Associate of Applied Science Degree in Facilities Maintenance Technology.
- Students are work-ready upon completion of the pathway.
- Training is on the State of Oregon Eligible Training Providers list (WIA).
- Students are prepared to sit for their brazing and CFC certifications at the conclusion of the pathway.
- Students participate in career planning seminars and receive job coaching services.
- A cohort learning community is developed and an employment specialist supports students as they pursue employment in the HVAC field.
- Pathway is held in a new lab facility located at PCC's Cascade Campus.
- This pathway is offered in partnership with PCC Cascade Trades and Industry Department.

Prerequisites

- High school diploma or GED.
- Completion of a COMPASS placement exam at a PCC testing center (results of the exam should place students into Writing 90, Reading 90, and Math 20. If test scores are below those listed above, please speak with the contact person listed for enrollment options).
