FULL-TIME FACULTY CO-OP ED WORKLOAD FACTOR

Teaching a Co-Op student in the field requires five contact hours per 12-week term. The contractual work load factor for Co-Op is .038. The table below applies that factor on a per student basis.

*The factor is calculated by dividing 1 by 12 weeks, multiplying the quotient (.083) by 5 hours, then multiplying the product by .038, which yields a .016 work load factor for each student.
