### Notes:

Developmental/Pre-College, includes all reading, writing, and math credit courses not coded as lower division transfer for state reporting. This category also includes pre-college math (levels above 20 and less than 100).

All Others category, includes Post Secondary Remedial, Self Improvement, and Non-reimbursable classes.

Due to unreported data, Category sums may not equal headcount totals.

Excluding FTE, College totals represent unduplicated students and do not equal the sum of campus variables. Campus calculations of part/full-time status and on-campus/distance learning also differ from College totals. (i.e. a student enrolled half-time at two different campuses would appear as a full-time student in the college calculation.)
