

## Getting started

1. Start from library home page: [www.pcc.edu/library](http://www.pcc.edu/library)
2. Click **Databases A-Z**.
3. Click the **E-F** shortcut, or scroll down to E.
4. Click **EBSCOhost**, then click **Continue**.
5. Alternately, from home page, click **Find Articles**, then **EBSCOhost**, then **Continue**.

## EBSCOhost choices

When you click EBSCOhost, you see the top two items checked, and a whole list of other options below. PCC Library has 33 databases through EBSCO; you can select these to search multiple databases at one time. The top two databases on the list – **Academic Search Premier** and **MasterFile Premier** – cover many topics. You may find that other EBSCO databases have more or different information on your topic.

Detailed Citation and Abstract

## Citation Format

AMA (American Medical Assoc.)

formats citation in different styles (MLA, APA, etc.)

# Tips

- Put quotes around phrases to indicate you want the words searched in that order, e.g. "graphic novels"
- Use truncation (\*) to get multiple versions of the word, e.g. teen\* = teen, teens, teenagers
- Use OR to combine synonyms to broaden a search, e.g. teen\* OR "young adult"
- Don't see the full-text link? Click **Get this item**: the computer checks to see if we have the full-text somewhere else. If we don't have it, you can request it through Interlibrary Loan.
