The Dental Assisting program requires all students caring for patients in their clinical experience carry a current CPR card which expires no earlier than Jun 30th of the graduating year. If your current card expires before this date, you must renew it prior to the expiration date. Students must provide proof of current card in order to register for fall term and to participate in clinical activities.

The Dental Assisting National Board (DANB) also requires a current CPR card in order to take certification exams.

DANB only accepts CPR certifications listed below. CPR certification from other organizations, or courses will not be accepted. The American Heart Association's Pediatric Basic Life Support course and Medic First Aid's CPR Inclusive course do not meet DANB's CPR requirement, as they do not contain both written and hands-on exams. First aid courses alone do not meet DANB's requirements, unless they include CPR courses.
