#### 1. Work Experience \_\_\_/20 Points Possible

>10 years = 10 pts, 5-10 years = 8 pts, 3-5 years = 5 pts, 1-2 years = 3 pts

\_\_\_ Length of service with employers  
>5 years = 10 pts, 3-5 years = 8 pts, 2-3 years = 5 pts, 1-2 years = 3 pts

> 2 years = 15 pts., 1-2 years = 10 pts., < 1 year = 8 pts.

> 2 years = 10 pts., 1-2 years = 8 pts., < 1 year = 5 pts.

\_\_\_ US / NM / RadTh Tech work experience  
> 2 years = 10 pts., 1-2 years = 8 pts., < 1 year = 5 pts.

\_\_\_ the top 40 applicants will assigned two hospital/clinic visitations where they will be interviewing /job shadowing in a MRI department.
