**Letter of Agreement Between  
Marylhurst College and  
Portland Community College  
An Articulation Project in Interior Design**

This Letter of Agreement has been enacted to facilitate the transfer of students taking Interior Design courses at Portland Community College to the Interior Design Program at Marylhurst College. The Agreement is the result of a project involving administrators and faculty of Marylhurst College and Portland Community College. The following areas have been agreed to and will be reviewed each year by the parties involved.

**I. Articulated Courses**

The following courses for PCC students have been approved for articulation. A course completed with a grade of "B" or above will be accepted in lieu of the equivalent Marylhurst College Course.
