

### Portland State University/Portland Community College Graphic Design A.A.S Transfer Agreement

Graduates from Portland Community College's Graphic Design A.A.S degree will transfer with a minimum of 99 credits to Portland State University with the following understandings:

The advisor will serve as the first-contact for transfer students and will provide an overview of the requirements for a degree, and will suggest a departmental adviser in the major.


All majors are open to these students. Suggested major is: Graphic Design, other majors may require prerequisites.


The Bachelor's of Art and/or the Bachelor's of Science will be inclusive of college eligibility, the seven-year catalog rule, general education, major and degree requirements as noted in the PSU Bulletin. Provided that there are at least 90 hours in transfer credits, students will have junior status. Students will have been advised at the community college regarding the BA/BS requirements in order to transfer either having met them or prepared to complete those requirements at PSU.


- All professional/technical classes of the Graphic Design A.A.S degree graded C or above and with prefix of 100 or above will be transferred **as noted on the attached addendum or as general electives.**
- Additional courses graded C or above and with a prefix of 100 or above will also transfer.
- Changes in these understandings will be communicated by either party in writing no later than June 30 of any academic year.

*NOTE: Transfer students will be required to submit a portfolio for review and approval by PSU's Graphic Design program, before registering for upper division (300/400) credits in that program at PSU. Also, PCC transfer students will need to complete 8 to 9 credits in History of Western Art in order to complete a Graphic Design major.*


