





## Portland State University/Portland Community College Gerontology Program Transfer Agreement

Graduates from Portland Community College who complete the Associate of Applied Sciences in the Gerontology Program may transfer to Portland State University with the following understandings:

1. Graduates will contact Robert Mercer, Senior Adviser, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, 725-5059/725-3822. He and his staff will serve as first-contact adviser for transfer students in the program, will provide an over-view of requirements for a degree, and will suggest an appropriate departmental adviser in the students major. All majors are open to these students. Portland Community College will help to assure that the students have taken appropriate academic courses in preparation for majors at PSU. For example, students intending to major in Psychology will be advised to take Statistics 243 and 244, and Psych 201 and 202 as part of their Associate degree in order to enter PSU prepared to enter their major at the junior level: students intending to major in Sociology will be advised to take Soc 201 and Stat 243. Academic advisers at PCC should call Mercer at 725-5059 with any specific questions.
2. All professional/technical classes and practica graded C or above taken at Portland Community College as part of the AAS in Gerontology will appear as general elective credit on transfer evaluations.
3. Provided that there are at least 90 hours in transfer credits, students will have junior status. Students with junior status will complete their general education requirements by completing a 12-credit upper division cluster, a 6-credit senior capstone project, and the requirements for either the bachelor of arts or the bachelor of science. The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (CLAS) Advising Office or the Information and Academic Support Center (IASC) can assist student in determining their general education choices.
4. Changes in these understandings will be communicated by either party in writing no later than June 30 of any academic year.
