TRANSFER ADMISSION DEADLINES:

Applications are accepted for Fall and Spring semesters and are reviewed on a rolling admissions basis. Admissions decisions are typically made within three weeks of receipt of a completed application package.

The priority application deadline for Fall admission is June 15th. The priority application deadline for Spring admission is January 1st. Admitted students will receive a formal acceptance package that includes a confirmation agreement, housing, and merit based scholarship information.

There is no minimum amount of semester hours required to apply as a transfer student to Pacific University. They will consider applicants who have finished one college level course or more. A minimum 2.7 GPA is preferred for admission.

Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree will be accepted by Pacific University as having met their general education core except for the foreign language and comparative culture requirements.

Associate of Science Transfer Degree will be accepted but Pacific's general education courses will need to be used in conjunction with the degree.
