Applicants must submit official academic records indicating a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average (4.00 scale) from each college or university attended. Applicants with fewer than 20 semester hours of college credit should also submit a high school academic record indicating a minimum of a 2.50 cumulative grade point average (4.00 scale) along with a minimum SAT combined score of 910 (1600 scale) or an ACT composite score of 19. Applicants not in good standing in any of these categories will be referred to the Admissions Review Committee for evaluation.

The completed application, including essay, \$50 application fee (non-refundable), official transcripts of all college work are required. A personal interview may be required.
