Transferable courses must:

- Be graded C (2.0) or better. No credit is granted for a C- or lower. Demonstration of a grade of C or better is required for transferability of Pass/Fail courses.
- Be 100-level or higher (exception of Math 095).
- Be academic in nature and correspond to course offerings at Linfield. Professional/technical courses won't transfer for academic credit.

Please note that students may transfer a maximum of 8 semester credits of paracurricular courses to Linfield (4 credits being the maximum for any one department), assuming the above criteria are met.
