Acceptance of Credit from a Two-Year Institution:

Only course work with a grade of C- or better, in a college-level course, will be accepted. (The grade point average does not transfer. Your GPA is computed on work at George Fox University only.)

A maximum of 64 semester hours (96 quarter hours) may be transferred from an accredited two-year college toward the bachelor’s degree.

Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree:

The Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer (AAOT) degree will satisfy all general education requirements except Bible and Religion provided students complete courses with a C- or better. The AAOT degree may not necessarily meet school, department, or major requirements with regard to courses or GPA.
