**ACCEPTANCE OF CREDIT FROM TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS:** In most cases, courses taken at regionally accredited colleges or universities will receive full credit if they are comparable to courses offered at Willamette. Courses with grades below a C- (C minus) will not receive credit. Six quarter hours or four semester hours of transfer credit equal one Willamette credit. A maximum of 15 Willamette credits will be awarded to transfer students.

**Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree:**

Students admitted with a college transfer Associate of Arts degree from an accredited community college will be automatically granted 15 Willamette credits (Junior standing) upon entrance, satisfaction of specific general requirements and major requirements will be determined on the basis of a course-by-course evaluation of the transcript(s).
