All full-time students are required to have medical insurance coverage. Unless specifically waived, showing proof of comparable coverage with another plan, students will be enrolled in a comprehensive medical insurance plan designed specifically for them and charged accordingly. Students opting for other coverage must complete a waiver form annually showing proof of comparable insurance.

CAMPUS VISIT: Transfer applicants are encouraged to visit the campus and schedule an interview with one of the transfer counselors 503-768-7040, e-mail at transfer@lclark.edu or go to their visitation page at <http://www.lclark.edu/visit/>. Interviews are most valuable when students bring a copy of their college transcript(s) for an initial evaluation of transfer credit.

ACCEPTANCE OF CREDIT FROM TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS: Transfer credit at Lewis & Clark is evaluated on a course-by-course basis. No block transferring is done, thus AA/transfer degrees will not automatically transfer. Credit is generally granted for college-level coursework done at other accredited institutions corresponding to what is offered within Lewis & Clark's liberal arts and sciences curriculum. Credit is granted only for classes in which a grade of C (2.0) or better was earned. Under no circumstances will credit be granted for college courses used in any way for high school graduation, College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), life experience, credit by examination, or distance-learning courses, including online correspondence and televised courses. Credit may not be granted for coursework completed over 20 years ago. A maximum of four semester credits of physical education/activity is allowed. You will be provided with an unofficial evaluation of your transfer credit with your offer of admission.
