ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

The Associate of Arts Oregon transfer degree (A.A.O.T.) from an Oregon community college and certain approved Associate's degrees from Arizona, California, Hawaii, and Idaho guarantees completion of the lower-division General Education Requirements, but does not guarantee junior standing or 60 semester credits. For details on specific degrees consult the WSU Vancouver Office of Admissions.

Applicants without a transferable Associate degree, but with at least 27 semester (40 quarter) hours of transferable credit from a regionally accredited post-secondary institution will normally be admitted as space allows, provided they have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average. Applicants whose cumulative grade point average is lower than a 2.5 will have their academic record reviewed more comprehensively to determine admission eligibility. If you have fewer than 27 semester (40 quarter) hours of transferable credit, you must also meet the freshman admission requirements. *Border Bill: Oregon residents of Clackamas, Clatsop, Columbia, Gilliam, Hood River, Morrow, Multnomah, Sherman, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Wasco, and Washington counties pay in-state tuition for up to 8 credits per semester. If students enroll in more than 8 credits, they will pay non-resident tuition for all credits.
