Corban College accepts the Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer degree with the following conditions:

1. All course work must be 100 level or higher.
2. The AAOT does not meet Biblical requirements.
3. It may not always meet the Thought and Culture sequences which are required for Corban's bachelor degree. The Thought and Culture courses must be satisfied with 16 semester hours in U.S. History, Western Civilization, Literature and Fine Arts.
4. It must include 62 semester hours (93 quarter hours) with a grade of "C-" or higher in all transferrable courses to enter with junior class standing.
