General Admissions Requirements for Transfer Students

Applicants with at least 24 semester (36 quarter) credits are evaluated on their academic achievement and courses completed at prior institutions. A minimum 2.25 GPA is required. The quality of the applicant's involvement in church, community, and school is also taken into account. Official transcripts from each college attended is required and evaluated for appropriate transfer of credit. If fewer than 24 semester (36 quarter) credits have been completed, an official high school transcript and ACT or SAT 1 score must also be submitted. The Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer (AAOT) degree satisfies all NCC general education requirements except 8 semester credits in Bible & Christian Ministry.

Limitations

- A maximum of 12 semester (18 quarter) credits of non-graded (P/NP) courses (except where P/NP is the only option)
- A maximum of 8 semester (12 quarter) credits of PE will be accepted. No more than two with same course number
- A maximum of 8 semester (12 quarter) credits of music performance credits, unless they relate to the major
- A maximum of 16 semester (24 quarter) credits of cooperative work experience
- A maximum of 30 semester (45 quarter) credits allowed through AP or CLEP or ACE equivalency
- No maximum military, fire, or police credits, but all accepted credits must fulfill graduation requirements
- No maximum vocational/technical credits, but all accepted credits must fulfill graduation requirements

PCC endeavors to create accurate transfer guides for students; however, requirements may change without notice. Students are responsible for working with PCC advisors and their transfer institution to ensure that their academic plan will meet requirements and timelines.
