

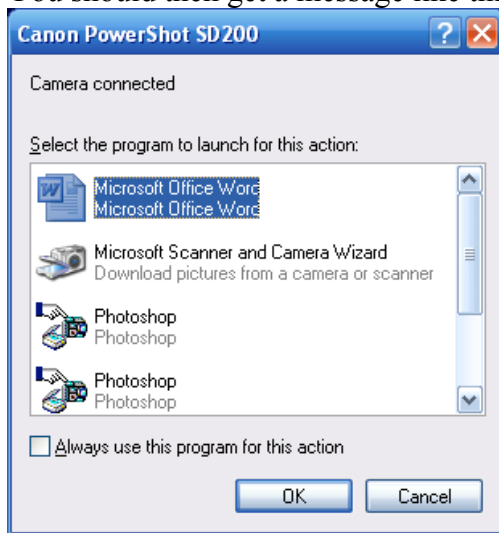
Getting Photos off of the Camera & on to the Computer



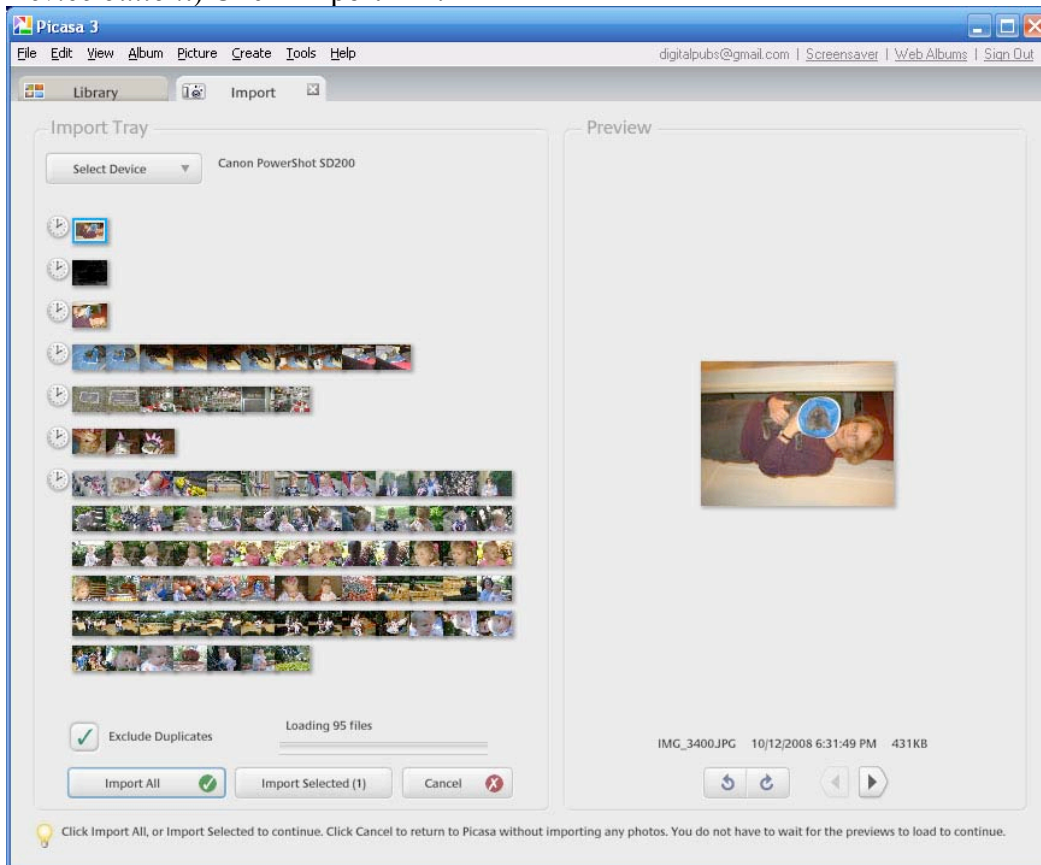
Your camera most likely came with a USB cable like the one below. Plug the smaller end into the camera and the larger end into a USB port on your computer. (Don't worry about plugging into the wrong place. Each should only fit into its correct input.)



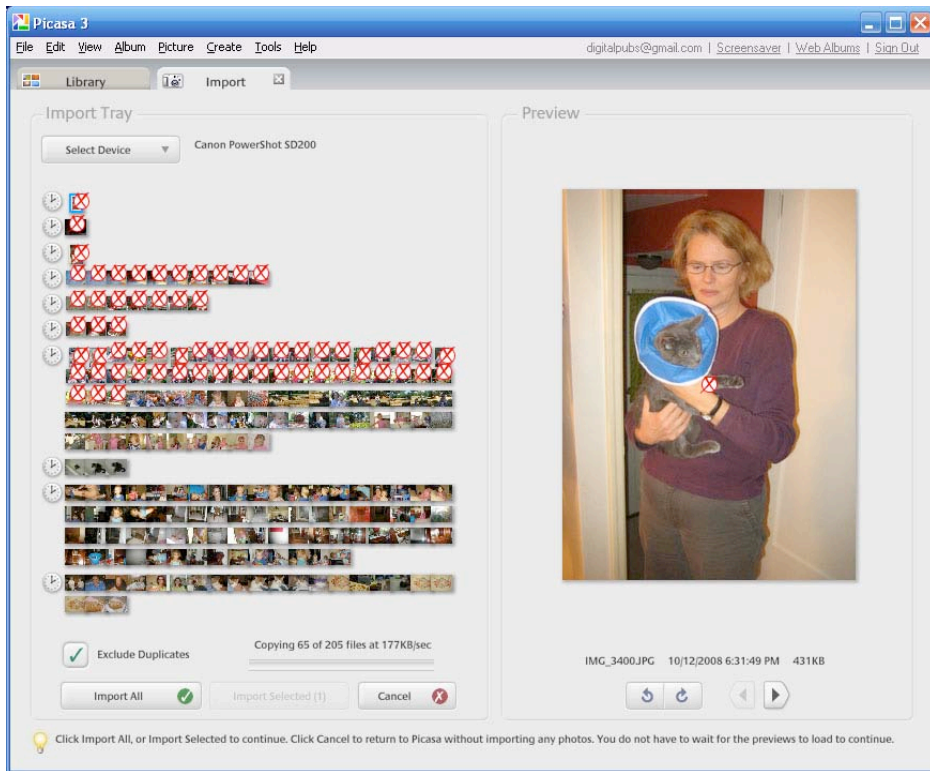
After you plug your camera in with the USB cable, turn it on in the photo review mode. You should then get a message like this on your computer. Click Cancel & Open Picasa.



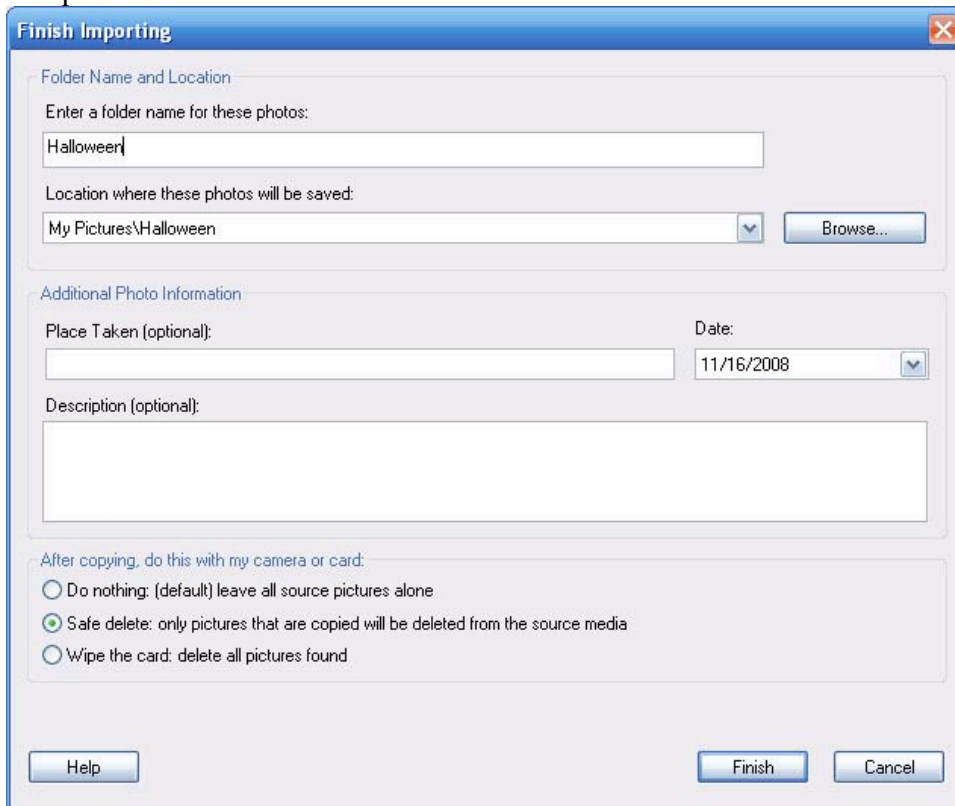
Click the Import button in Picasa (it's in upper left corner.) Your device should be automatically selected already. (If it's not, make sure your camera is in the photo review mode. Or try the Select Device button.) Click 'Import All'.



Picasa will automatically exclude out any photos that have already been downloaded, preventing duplicates on your computer. Duplicates are indicated by the red X. If you want to include them in your download, click 'Exclude Duplicates' to uncheck it.



Click 'Import All'. The screen below will appear. Enter a folder name and any other description you want. Then decide if you want to delete the photos from your camera after you transfer them to your computer. I use the 'Safe delete' button. Then click 'Finish'.



It will take a few minutes but then your photos will appear in Picasa. You can now unplug the USB cable and turn off your camera.
