Degrees/Certificates

- Looked at AS, AAOT, & AGS degrees with move to 4-credit courses
- Recommended general education & sequence requirements with move to 4-credit
- Reviewed several PTE certificates and degrees

Policy Committee

- Recommended implementation of 4-credit courses which will happen over next 2 years
- Discussed mandatory pre-requisites. Bringing recommendation to EAC today.

Future:

- 5-year rule for math and writing classes
- Discuss requiring a college survival course for students with low test scores
- Discussion of grade inflation
- Discuss validity of totally online degree

Curriculum Committee

- Recommended 62 new courses and changes to 251 existing courses
- 3-4 credit subcommittee reviewed 143 courses in 18 disciplines using streamlined process

Trends:

- Conflicts between SACs seem to be diminishing. Learning to work it out together.
- Prerequisites and recommendations more commonly being included in courses.

Student Development Committee

- Revised Students Rights and Responsibilities Policies Handbook
- Revised the Student Academic Progress policy

Membership Committee

- Had more requests for members than opening; 5 FT faculty, 10 PT faculty, 5 classified expressed interest with no room.
