Publishing to Spot Account with Mozilla 1.x and Netscape 7.x Composer

Both Mozilla 1.x and Netscape 7.x come with an improved web page editor that can help you create and edit pages quickly without having to know HTML. Composer creates pages that are compatible with most web browsers, and doesn't insert proprietary code that often doesn't work correctly on other computers. It also allows you to view the tags, view the source, and preview the file all from one location. Plus, its free!

Publishing Settings for Spot

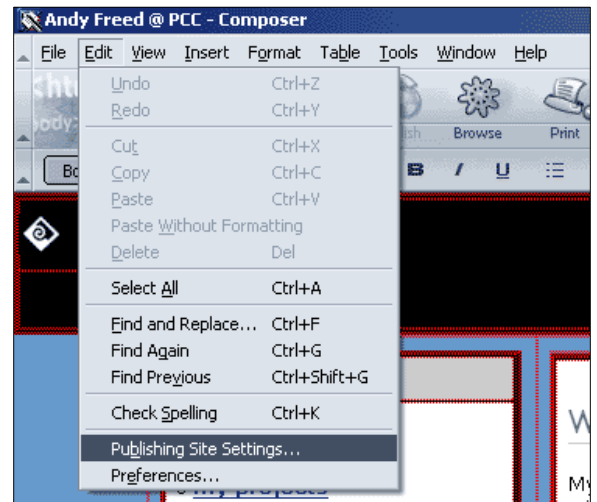
If you're going to be publishing a web site on Spot, Composer can help you. Here's how to configure it to do so:

Click on the Edit menu and select Preferences...

Click on Publishing Site Settings...

The settings will be slightly different for personal accounts and department sites. The instructions for the Department sites is on the second page.

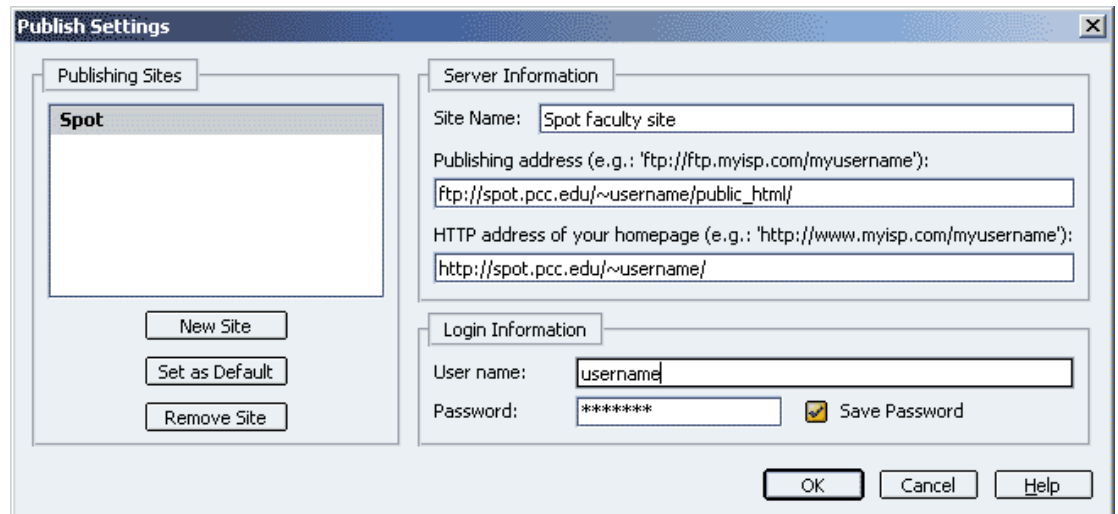
To request a spot account, fill out the form located at <http://www.pcc.edu/resources/web/staff/spot/>



Settings for User Accounts

Fill out the settings window with the following information:

- Site Name: anything that makes sense to you
- Publishing address: ftp://spot.pcc.edu/~username/public_html/ (use your username)
- HTTP address: <http://spot.pcc.edu/~username/>
- Username: your account username
- Password: your password
- Check Save Password if you want it to remember your password. (Not



recommended for shared computers, labs, etc)

- Click OK.

Settings for Group/Department Accounts

Publishing to a Department or Group site is slightly different. You'll still use your own username & password, but you'll need to change the publishing directory and HTTP address to match your department's site. Fill out the settings window with the following information:

- Site Name: anything that makes sense to you
- Publishing address: <ftp://spot.pcc.edu/~username/department site/> (use your username and department name)
- HTTP address: <http://spot.pcc.edu/department site/>
- Username: your account username
- Password: your password
- Check Save Password if you want it to remember your password. (Not recommended for shared computers, labs, etc)
- Click OK.
