



Math Fest 2019

What: Math Fest is a fun and free event hosted by Portland Community College to engage students in mathematics. Middle and high school students can compete for prizes and high school students can qualify for the Oregon Invitational Mathematics Tournament (OIMT).

When: Saturday, April 6th from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm. Check-in begins at 8:30 am with exams beginning at 9 am sharp, and then games, activities, and awards to follow.

Who: All high school and middle school students are welcome at the event. Students must be registered in advance to participate in an exam. We request that each school sends a school representative to chaperone students. Parents are also welcome to attend.

Registration: We offer the following exams: Prealgebra, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Precalculus, or Some Calculus. Students may choose which exam they would like to take, and then sign up with their teacher. In the months leading up to the event, there will be two rounds in the registration process. We will first request an approximate headcount followed later by a list of student names and exam level.

Awards: Awards and prizes are given to top ranking students. Both middle and high school students may earn recognition and PCC prizes. High school students who rank in the top 12% on the Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Precalculus, or Some Calculus exams may earn an invitation to the Oregon Invitational Mathematics Tournament (OIMT).
