Federal Emergency Grants for Fiscal Quarter Ending on 3/31/2022

PCC signed and submitted the U.S. Department of Education (ED) Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CARES Act on April 16, 2020, and has subsequently drawn down supplemental grant funds which constitutes agreement with the CRRSA and ARP Acts' Supplemental Certifications and Agreements.

PCC has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSA and ARP (a)(1) program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

Federal Emergency Grant Reporting

The estimated total number of students potentially eligible to receive HEERF Grants in this quarter was 23,086

A net total of \$14,182,707 was disbursed to 9,457 students during the quarter.

Cumulatively, \$33,665,812 of \$33,665,814 (100.0%) has been distributed to students by PCC as of end of Q1, 2022.

Federal Emergency Grant Criteria and Eligibility

For Fall 2021 and Winter 2022, all registered students (excluding Community Education courses) may be eligible for CRSSA and ARP funds. Students were invited to complete an opt-in form to indicate need for emergency grant funds. All recipients will receive the same amount of funds.
