REPORT: The proposed Electronic Engineering Technology Less Than One-Year Career Pathway Certificate replaces the Electronic Engineering Technology 1-Year Certificate. This change allows students to complete the certificate in 3 terms instead of 4 terms, thereby accelerating placement into a career pathway. This career pathway certificate prepares students for entry-level positions in electronics engineering technology. All courses in the 42-credit certificate are embedded in the Electronic Engineering Technology AAS.

RECOMMENDATION: That the College be authorized to submit an application to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the Electronic Engineering Technology Less Than One-Year Career Pathway Certificate for Portland Community College.
