REPORT: The proposed Emergency Medical Technician Less Than One-Year Career Pathway Certificate prepares students with entry-level positions as in a variety of emergency medical settings. The 12-credit certificate curriculum is comprised of two courses that allow students to be eligible to sit for the National Registry exams which lead to state licensure. All courses in the certificate are embedded in the Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic AAS and the Emergency Medical Services One-Year Certificate.

RECOMMENDATION: That the College be authorized to submit an application to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the Emergency Medical Technician Less Than One-Year Career Pathway Certificate for Portland Community College.
