REPORT:	At the April 18 th , 2019, the Board approved BA19-100 to affirm Board policy on COBID participation on bond-funded projects and to establish aspirational goals for workforce diversity on construction projects.
	The College has determined that the most cost-effective way to track construction workforce diversity is to partner with the City of Portland Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services. The City has an established unit that provides these services for the City and other public agencies in the Metro area. Partnering with the City will save the College the costs of acquiring specialized software to track and report this data and the staff costs of entering data and producing reports.
	The proposed price from the City is \$58,508 annually to track six (6) projects a year. Over the life of the 2017 bond the anticipated costs are \$234,032.
RECOMMENDATION:	That the Board of Directors authorize PCC to execute an Inter-Governmental Agreement with the City of Portland for Construction Workforce Diversity reporting services. Funding will be from 2017 Bond Funds.
