REPORT: At its meeting on February 27, 2020 the board approved

resolution 20-105 to award the contract for CM/GC services for the Portland Metropolitan Workforce Training Center to Anderson Construction. This approval covered up to

\$165,000 in preconstruction services.

As the project design has developed it has been determined that the new construction should be a mass timber building. While this does not impact the expected overall project budget it does require that key sub-contractors are brought into the pre-construction phase earlier than planned to provide critical input into the design process. Anderson Construction has submitted a change proposal to the pre-construction phase of \$299,444 to add pre-construction

Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) is submitted it will reflect moving these costs from that phase of the project to the current phase. P&CC staff have reviewed the proposal and

recommend acceptance.
