REPORT:	The proposed Less Than One-Year Certificate in Geospatial UAS is designed to prepare students as trained specialists in a wide variety of fields including Agriculture, Emergency Services, Atmospheric Sciences, and Geospatial services. This 12-credit certificate also covers how to ethically operate drones; plan flights for a variety of data collection types using appropriate sensors and tools; and to process, interpret and analyze the data being collected.
RECOMMENDATION:	That the College be authorized to submit an application to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the Less Than One-Year Certificate in Geospatial UAS for Portland Community College.
