REPORT: Board Policy B703 reserves to the Board "...sole authority to

approve naming of College campuses, sites, buildings, facilities, parts of facilities, and faculty and staff positions."

The PCC site in Scappoose is 17.25 acres and has the capacity for multiple buildings on the property. Due to the ability to house numerous facilities for varying academic purposes the site should be consistent with our other center location names. This consistency will allow flexibility for future expansions on the site. Naming the site Columbia County Center meets the goal of consistency with other locations, creates a name that serves the broader

community and county, and allows flexibility for the future.

The first building on the site should reflect the academic mission of the programs in the building, the partnership with OMIC R&D, and state and community support and shall be

named the OMIC Training Center.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the Scappoose site be named PCC

Columbia County Center and the first building OMIC Training

Center.
