REPORT: The proposed Maritime Shipfitter and Welder Less Than

One-Year Career Pathway Certificate will provide training

in advanced welding theory and application for the marine industry. Focus includes: Ship Fitting, Oxyfuel Cutting, Carbon Arc Gouging (CAC-A), Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW) and Flux Cored Arc Welding (FCAW). After completing this certificate, students can apply for entry-level welding positions. The maritime welding content will give students a competitive

advantage for positions in shipyard environments. This 12-credit certificate prepares students to weld both indoor and the outdoor settings in all weather conditions and in

confined spaces. Students will test for a range of

maritime recognized certifications including ABS, AWS

and NAVSEA certifications.
