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Planning Requirements

According to Governor Kate Brown's Executive Order 20-28, not later than September 1, 2020, Portland Community College (PCC) must develop and submit to its governing board and the governing board must approve a written COVID-19 Health and Safety Operational plan.

The plan must describe how the College will comply with the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) standards for in-person instructional, research and residential activities.

Planning Process

In developing the written plan in compliance with these requirements, PCC assembled a planning team and consulted with content experts, Local Public Health Authorities and with representatives of other interested parties, including but not limited to administration, faculty, classified staff, and students.

The COVID-19 Opening Leadership Team (COLT) oversaw this process, reviewed the final version of the plan in detail, and recommended that the President submit the plan to the Board for approval.
