



These floor plans are provided to help orient the viewer to each view on the following pages. Arrows indicate the location and direction of view, numbers correspond to the page of the view.








Levels 1-3 | Atrium Section

View of the atrium cut through the building, looking west. New atrium stairs improve wayfinding; more collaboration spaces are in daylight; new acoustic panels buffer sound; recessed doorways with a yellow accent color support wayfinding; a new elevator unifies floors; collaboration spaces alternate around the atrium to create a variety of experiences; double-height decorative lights further connect the levels.



Level 3 | Large Open Collaboration Space

View of level 3 flexible multi-purpose collaboration space, which will be used for Architecture and Interior Design critique, among other uses, including students working together in small or large groups, or individually. Pin-up space continues into the corridor, and the view shows the new consolidated building entry from the north. The reclaimed wood is a sustainable material that also connects to the history of the building.





Level 3 | Atrium

View of the atrium cut through the building, looking west. New atrium stairs improve wayfinding; more collaboration spaces have access to daylight; new acoustic panels buffer sound; recessed doorways with a yellow accent color aid with wayfinding; a new elevator unifies floors; collaboration spaces alternate around the atrium to create a variety of experiences; double-height decorative lights further connect the levels.





Level 3 | Small Open Collaboration Space

View of level 3 looking toward the CC building. The comfortable collaboration area is just outside the building's largest meeting room.





Level 3 | Highlighted Classroom Entries

View showing level 3 corridor pin-up, architecture and interior design classroom entrances, and a new meeting room at the end of the corridor. A yellow accent color has been added at lab and classroom entries as a wayfinding strategy that continues throughout the building.






Level 3 | Typical General Purpose Classroom






Level 3 | Architecture and Interior Design Studio

Level 2 | Open Collaboration Space

View of level 2 atrium space, looking south. This large, shared space offers collaboration areas at various scales, with a variety of furniture options for group or individual study. A green accent color highlights the nursing suite entry. Atrium spaces receive more natural light.

Decorative lighting visually connects levels 2 and 3; acoustic treatment attenuates sound; repurposed wood connects to the building's history.



Level 2 | Academic Offices Entry

View of level 2 consolidated academic office suite entry looking east. The green accent color indicates suite entries through the building, the new central stair offers a more direct, but visually lighter, connection between floors.





Level 3 | Academic Offices - Open Office Area

View of level 2 consolidated academic office space looking south to views of the courtyard between the HT building and the CC building.



Level 2 | Nursing Skills Lab

View of the Nursing Skills Lab, looking north. The lab features flexible learning space at the center, small enclosed rooms for hybrid teaching and testing at the perimeter.


Level 1 | Open Collaboration Space - Looking North

Level 1 | Fitness Center Reception


View looking east from the fitness center entry, the teaching/stretching space is to the immediate left, the check-in counter is to the immediate right.
