

Sylvania Communications Technology

- Full renovation of existing Brutalist building to accommodate Arts & Humanities programs
- Scope includes replacement of all MEPF systems and building assemblies. Scope also includes site improvements to the surrounding area & the PAC Plaza
- Estimated Completion: May 2028










Sylvania East Entry Site Improvements

- Redesign of the existing main entry to increase accessibility and circulation into campus, while also expanding opportunities for alternative transportation methods and improving safety
- Scope includes the East entry as well as the Bookstore Plaza
- Estimated Completion: May 2028









Rock Creek Building 2

- Scope includes renovation of B2 and establishing new CTE space for the Construction Technologies and Automotive Services programs
- Total Project Budget is \$84M
- The Design Team and CM/GC partners were selected via separate RFPs
 - Bora Architects
 - Fortis Construction
- Programming to begin late Summer 2024
- Estimated construction start in Spring 2026

Hillsboro Health & Education District Partnership with Hillsboro School District and Virginia Garcia Memorial Health Center

- Early massing study proposed a 90,000 sf building
- PCC would have about 30,000 sf for health-related programs
- Total PCC Project Budget is \$20M
- Memorandum of Understanding finalized
- Now discussing terms for a Development Agreement



Technology

Wireless Upgrades

- Phase 1 complete
 - Replaced over 800 access points district-wide
 - Upgraded all associated network switches
 - Wireless related support tickets reduced by 80%
 - Phase 2 underway to add additional APs with a planned completion of Fall 2024

Presentation Technology

- 193 classroom podium upgrades installed since 2017
- 2022 podium upgrades currently in RFP and beginning after Summer
- A/V refreshes in SY CC and RC EC going to bid this summer

Safety & Security

Security Camera Replacements

 Currently in planning phase to inventory existing security cameras district-wide and evaluate replacements, additions, maintenance and administrative processes. To be complete in 2025

Evaluating possible solutions and compatibility with PCC's existing technology



Use of Bond Funds

IRS and State restricts the use of tax-exempt bond proceeds

- Must result in a capital asset (useful life over one year)
- Cannot be used for software unless College owns the product does not apply to incidental use e.g. operating systems and software required for equipment. This is a limitation in the State Constitution
- Cannot be used for "ordinary" repair and maintenance
- Cannot be used for salaries and operating expenses other than those required to manage the bond program
- Additionally, expenditures must comply with ballot measure language






Workforce & Contracting Equity

- Added Respectful Workplace Program requirements for design teams
- Hired a Vendor Diversity Coordinator Tina Semko
- Implementing a workforce agreement on the RC Building 2 project in partnership with labor and CBOs
- Engaged NAMC as a partner to maximize contracting equity - working to add PBDG as a partner
- Our Respectful Workplace Program language adopted by TriMet, Metro, PPS, BSD, Wash Co



Regional Workforce Equity Agreement (RWEA)

- Agreement amongst government agencies and organized labor working toward dramatically improving the hiring and retention of women and people of color on construction projects around the region. Brings all stakeholders to the table collaboratively
- Finalizing the PCC specific owners attachment
 - worked with Attorney who prepared the master agreement
 - Next step is reaching out to the unions for agreement
 - Will be implemented on the RC B2 project as a pilot
