

STOP CAMPUS HAZING ACT

The **Stop Campus Hazing Act** is a federal law that expands institutional transparency and reporting requirements related to hazing at institutions of higher education. The Act requires colleges and universities to:

- Prohibit hazing and clearly define hazing in institutional policy
- Establish procedures for reporting hazing incidents
- Publish a **Campus Hazing Transparency Report** summarizing any findings of hazing involving student organizations
- Provide hazing prevention education and awareness information

These requirements are intended to promote accountability, improve campus safety, and increase transparency around hazing related behavior.

CAMPUS HAZING TRANSPARENCY REPORT

In compliance with the Stop Campus Hazing Act, Portland Community College publishes a **Campus Hazing Transparency Report**. This report summarizes any substantiated findings of hazing involving student organizations during the applicable reporting period. If no hazing incidents are substantiated, the report will reflect that finding.
