## Notes:

Due to the COVID pandemic the April DAC meeting was cancelled. Business items submitted to the April meeting that could be delayed were moved to the May meeting. One item was time sensitive and was voted on asynchronously. The May meeting will be a remote video meeting.

### Old Business –

#### NEW AAS-INTP: ASL/English Interpreting Program AAS Degree

- This degree was initially recommended for approved by the DAC at the January meeting with two courses listed as optional: ITP 282 Practicum III and ITP 284 Internship II. Subsequent discussion revealed that this structure did not meet the needs of the program which is for students to take either ITP 282 or ITP 284 (with these courses listed as optional the students technically had the option of taking neither). To have the degree function as intended the following changes were approved by an asynchronous vote with all voting members participating:
  - The removal of the optional courses and the addition of 3 credits of ASL/Interpreting Electives. This increased the credits in the degree from 91 to 94.
  - The creation of the ASL/Interpreting Elective List which includes ITP 282 (Practicum III) and ITP 284 (Internship II). Each course is 3 credits.
