#### Credential

#### **AAS-EXS: Exercise Science AAS Degree**

- New EXS Degree and Certificate Outcomes were developed to ensure that the EXS program is staying relevant to the needs of the industry and industry partners, aligning with current best practices, and meeting educational and career student goals.
- Added PE 250 as a ProAct option.

#### ACERTP-EXPT: Personal Trainer Less Than One-Year Career Pathway Certificate

- New EXS Degree and Certificate Outcomes were developed to ensure that the EXS program is staying relevant to the needs of the industry and industry partners, aligning with current best practices, and meeting educational and career student goals.
- Added PE 250 as a ProAct option.

#### **AAS-FP: Fire Protection Technology AAS Degree**

- Removed the CTE stand-alone course of FP and replaced it with SOC 213.
- This course fulfills the following GE requirement: Cultural Literacy, Cultural Literacy/DIV, Social Sciences/SS allowing students the opportunity to double dip with this required course and work towards the Black Studies Focus Award, Peace and Conflict Focus Award & Social Justice Focus Award.
- Total credits increased from 90 to 91 credits.

#### **AAS-GREN**: Gerontology AAS Degree

- Changes relate to the elimination of courses based on certificate discontinuations within our program.
- The decrease in the number of required GRN 280A Gerontology Internship credits is based on revised industry standards from the Academy of Gerontology in Higher Education.

#### ACERTP-GRP: Gerontology Professional Less Than One-Year Career Pathway Certificate

- Changes relate to the elimination of courses based on certificate discontinuations within our program.
- Total credits decreased from 41 to 38 credits.

#### **AAS-MICA: Automated Manufacturing Technology AAS Degree**

- Adjusted course content to align with new course offerings.
- Total credits decreased from 98 to 90 credits.

#### **AAS-MICS: Solar Voltaic Manufacturing Technology AAS Degree**

- Adjusted course content to align with new course offerings.
- Total credits decreased from 99 to 91 credits.

#### **AAS-MICT: Microelectronics Technology AAS Degree**

- Adjusted course content to align with new course offerings.
- Total credits decreased from 103 to 95 credits.

#### **ACERT-MEC: Mechatronics Less Than One-Year Certificate**

- Merged content from MT150 into MT151.
- Total credits decreased from 42 to 38 credits.

#### ACERTP-SOV: Solar Voltaic Manufacturing Technology: Career Pathway Certificate

• Adjusted course content to align with new course offerings.

#### **AAS-OMT: Ophthalmic Medical Technology AAS Degree**

- Added new course OMT 260.
- OMT 232 and OMT 233 Seminar courses have been reduced to 1 credit each.

#### AAS-VEM: Video Production & Emerging Media AAS Degree

• Added several additional classes as 'or' to provide flexibility.

#### **NEW: ACERT-ADIT: Counselor In Training Less Than One-Year Certificate**

- The courses in the certificate map to the Mental Health and Addiction Certification Board of Oregon (MHACBO) level 1 certification and were developed with industry partners. These courses and this certificate were created to help fill the gap of Spanish speaking counselors and counselors in training in the Portland metro area.
- This certificate is designed for people who are working in the substance use field but are not certified.

#### **ACERT1-MA: Medical Assisting One-Year Certificate**

Added MP 111 and MA 114.

• Total credits increased from 47 to 52 credits.
