Common Course Numbering Update

- Courses that must align with CCN system for the 2023-24 catalog:
 - o Communication 100Z, 111Z, 218Z
 - o Math 105Z, 111Z, 112Z
 - o Statistics 243Z
 - o Writing 121Z, 122Z, 227Z
 - o PCC Honors courses: WR 121, WR 122, COMM 111
 - These courses have the same prerequisites as non-Honors courses with one additional Honors outcome.
 - There are 13 courses for PCC because we want to ensure that our Honors courses will be accepted by other institutions for transfer purposes.
- The college has to adopt the state titles, course descriptions, outcomes, and numbering for these courses.
 - o PCC's COMM 214 will be changed to COMM 218.
 - o PCC's MTH 243 will be changed to STAT 243.
- Local institutions are permitted to add up to 25% of additional description and outcomes.
- SACs have until 4/27 to let the Curriculum Office know if they want to add any additional information.
- At the May curriculum meeting, CCOGs for those 13 courses will come through as agenda items with state requirements only, or with state requirements plus additional description and outcomes.
- By this time next year, there should be a separate CCOG form with space for the additional information.
 - o A potential problem will be how we can ensure that state requirements aren't accidentally changed during the approval process.
