Justification: The current 21 months AAS Degree Program for OMT is being revised to a 12 month Certificate Level Program to better meet the needs of the industry. A shorter program will allow access to more students, and meet the needs of the ophthalmic community. The current OMT AAS degree will be eliminated at the end of the Summer 2025 term.

Justification: The MLT Program has been streamlined to better align the program content to the requirements of the national certification exam and the needs of entry-level employment as a lab technician. The changes include removing courses from the program that are no longer needed, consolidating courses to leverage content similarities, and streamlining course content. Lastly, the sequence of courses has been modified with an eye toward balancing credit load across terms and minimizing the amount of time students need to be on campus for labs.	
New Award - ACERT1-DA: Dental Assisting	DA SAC - Renee Lawson
Justification: This new certificate represents a comprehensive transformation of the entire Dental Assisting curriculum and program. Due to the significant amount of change to the curriculum the DA SAC is proposing a new certificate to accurately capture and implement those changes. The primary objectives of the curriculum changes were to reorganize course topics into more suitable courses, enhance alignment between courses, guarantee that students receive an adequate number of contact hours per course, and maintain an appropriate overall balance within the certificate program.
