ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States
- Must hold a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- Must have at least 3 years of fulltime teaching or administrative experience by time of departure
- Must be currently employed fulltime in a U.S. school, institution of higher education, Local Educational Agency, State Educational Agency, library, or museum as a teacher/ administrator
- Must be an educator in the Arts, Humanities, or Social Sciences (this criterion does **not** apply to administrators)
- Must be currently working at the grade level of the seminar
- Must be physically and psychologically able to participate

- Room and board
- Program-related travel within host country
