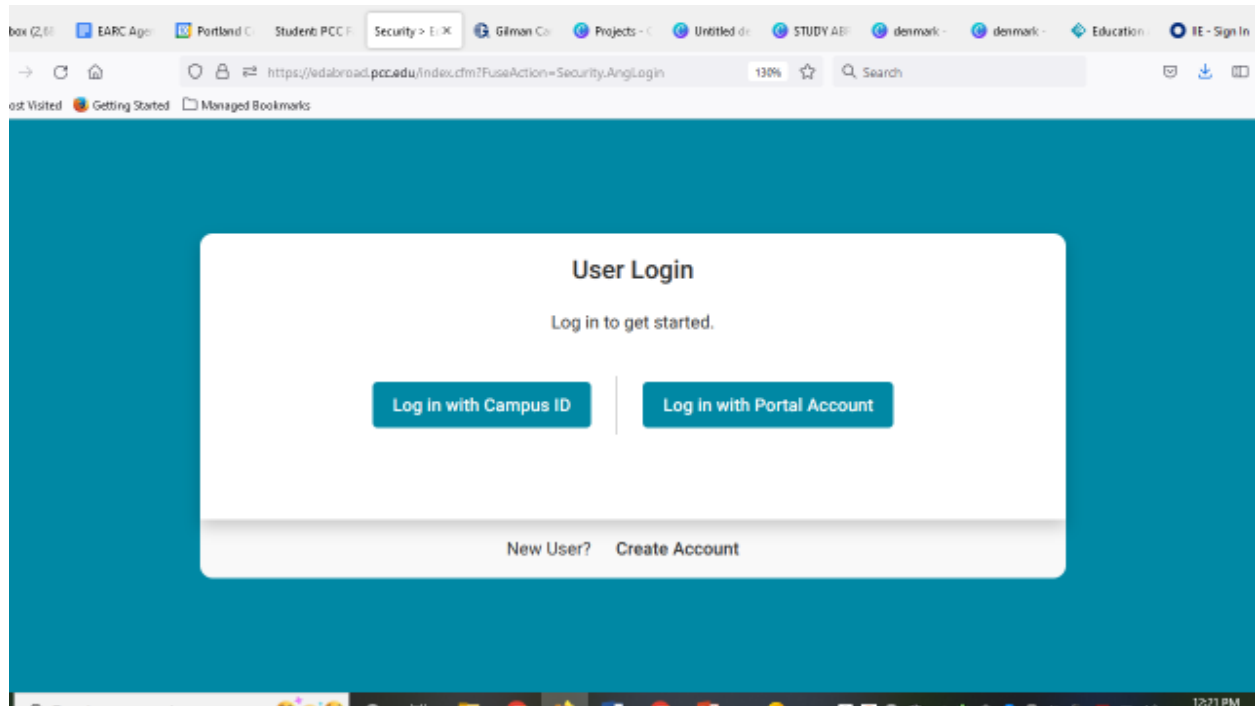

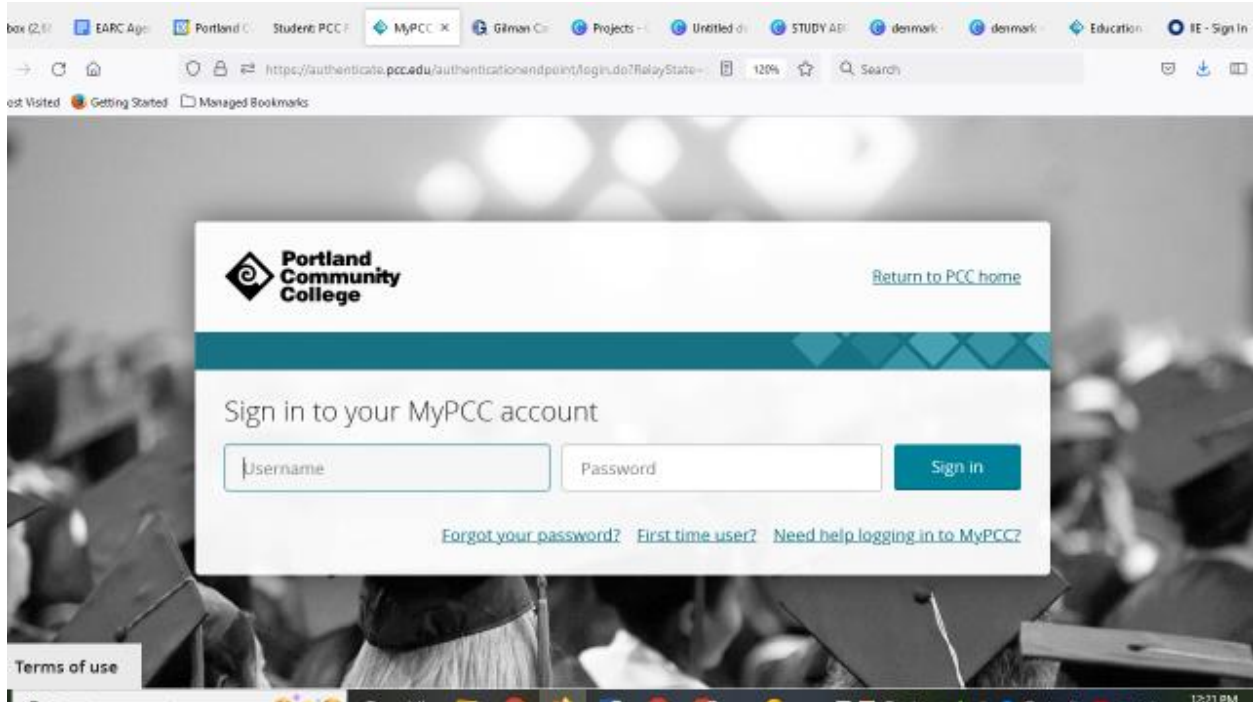

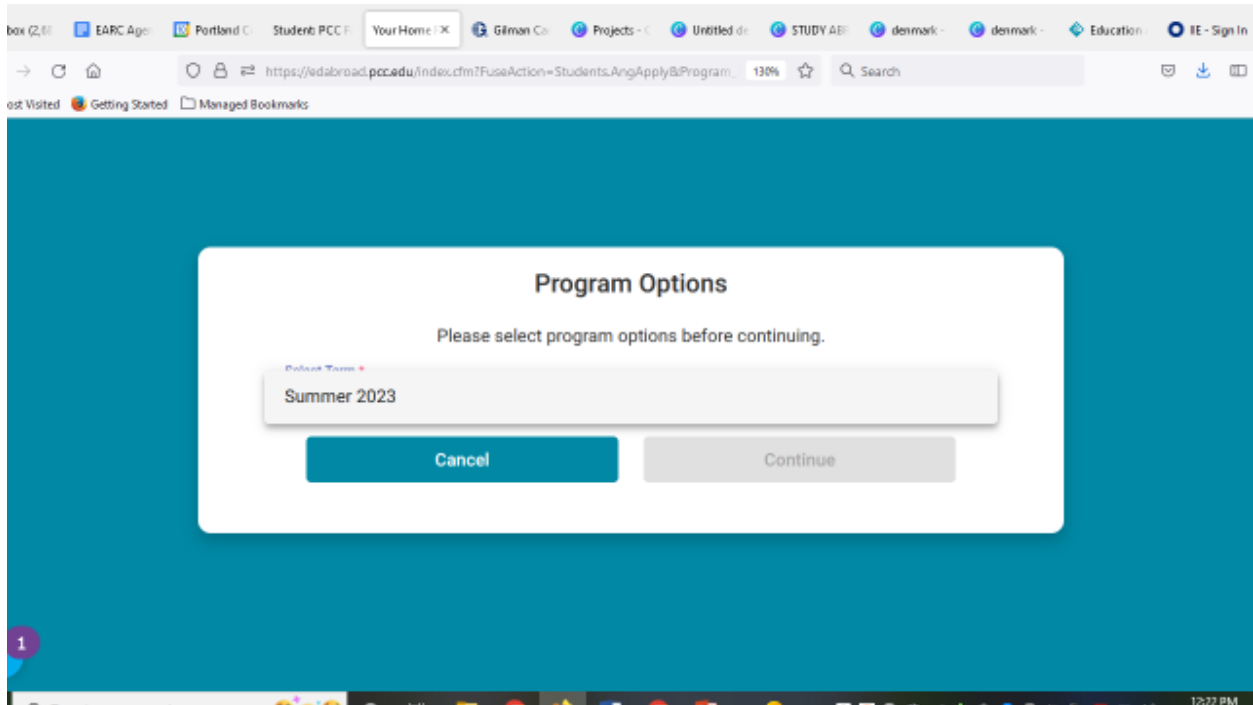

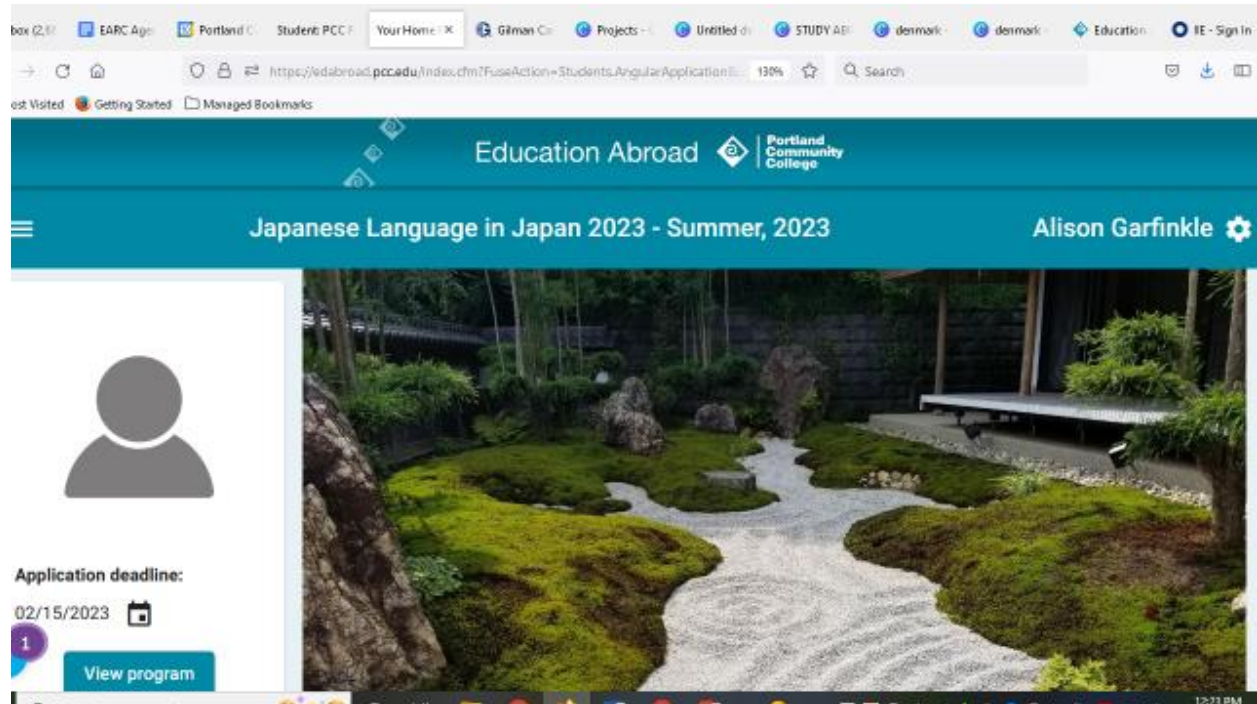
If you are currently enrolled in PCC classes and using the “Log In with Campus ID”, you will log in with your MyPCC credentials.



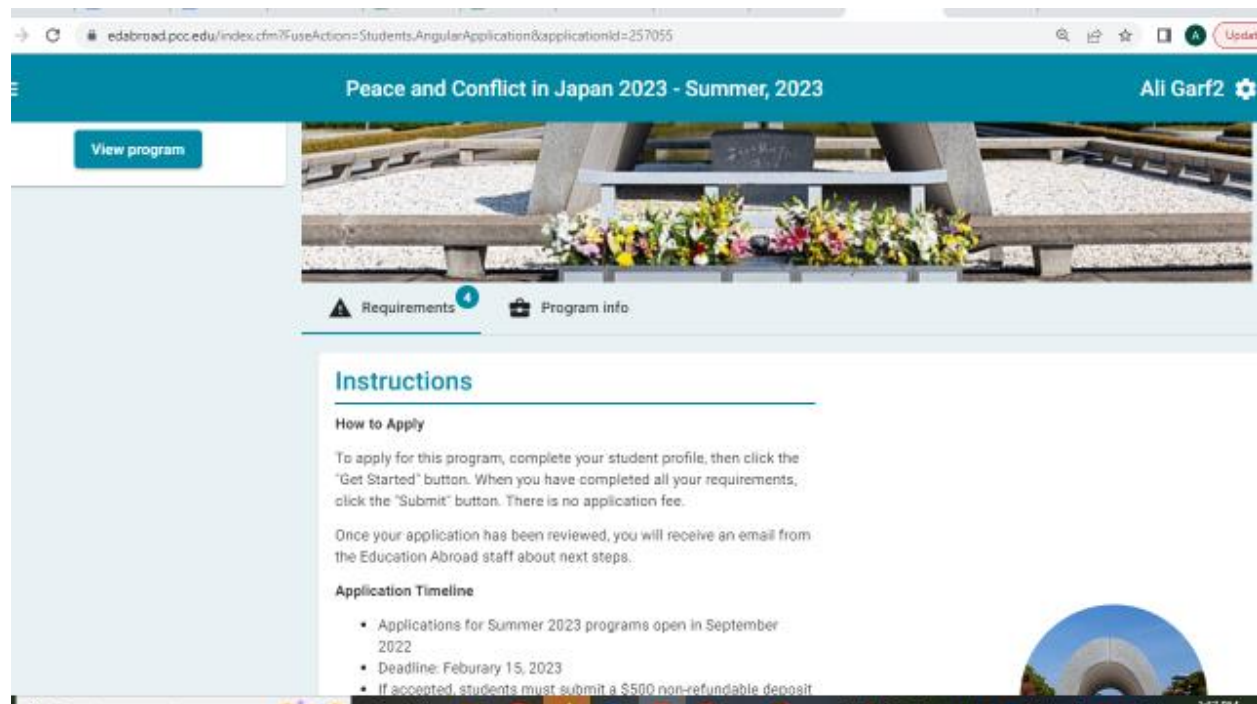
Choose “Summer 2023” and click “Continue”.




You will now see your application home page, with the Program Name at the top of your page. In this example, I am applying for the Japanese Language Program.



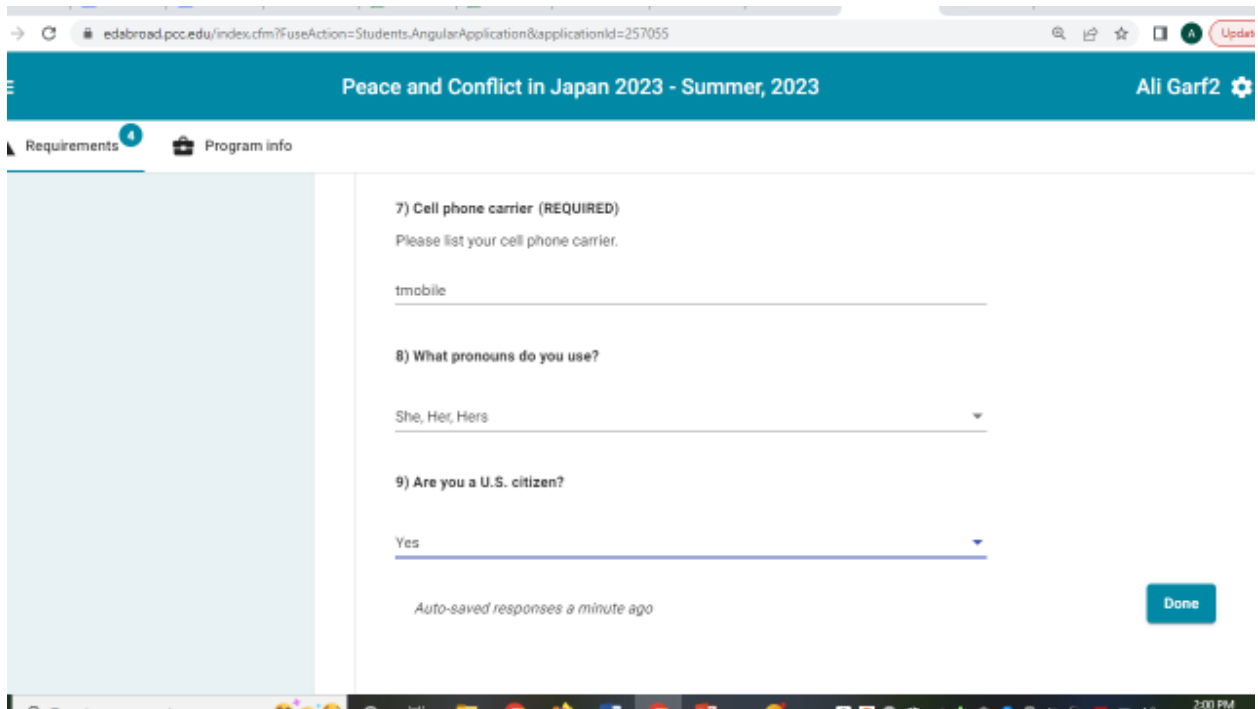

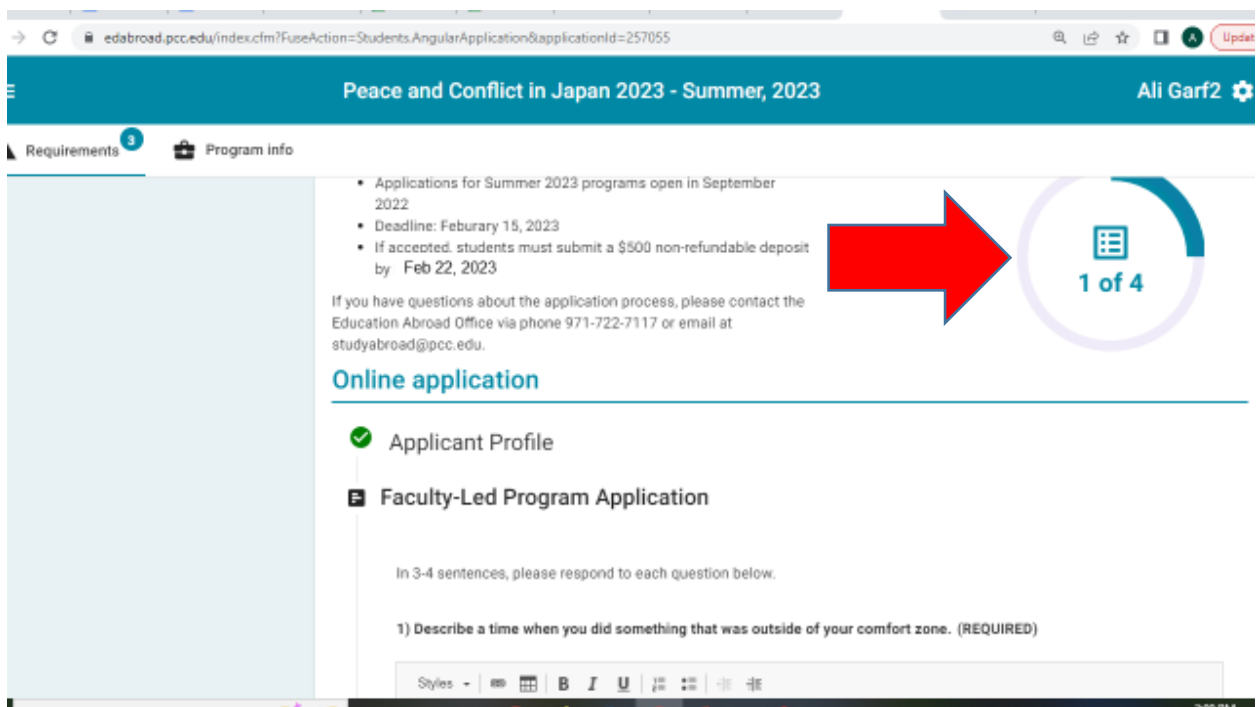
