



Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal

To be eligible for financial aid, you have to maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) by:

1. Maintaining a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher,
2. Passing at least 66.67% of attempted credits each term, and
3. Being on track complete a degree, certificate, or program.

If you don't meet these requirements for two terms in a row, your financial aid will be suspended.
