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

Somalia and US Marriage

Have you ever attended wedding ceremonies of different cultures? Marriage is important for human life, and it keeps the existence of human beings in this world. Without marriage no one could live in this world. The two basic elements of marriage are religion and culture. As the people have different cultures and religion, they also have different customs of their marriage. The wedding customs that Somalia and the US have are very different.

Religion takes the most important part of marriage for every society. In Somalia, as a Muslim country, people perform their wedding ceremonies under the sharia law. The sheikh (Islamic scholar) asks the bride, the groom, and the father of the bride for their consent to perform a nikah (a connection between couples). A dowry (money or valuable things like gold) should be mentioned for the bride. The sheikh finally performs a nikah and announces the marriage of the couple. In the USA, usually a pastor or priest who has the authority by the government performs marriages and the ceremony is held at church. The bride and the groom say their vows to each other and exchange the wedding rings. Finally, the person in authority announces that they are husband and wife.

The kind of food that one society likes to eat makes them to be different from other societies. When attending a Somali wedding ceremony, meat with rice that is specially cooked is the most important food that everyone who attends the ceremony likes to eat. Halwa, which is a traditional sweet is also something people like to eat at the wedding ceremonies. Samosa, which is another traditional snack, has its own specialty for the Somali wedding ceremonies. The USA has many traditional food and drinks for their wedding ceremonies. Fruit, beef kabobs, fresh salads, salmon, chicken, seafood, coffee/tea, water and juice are among the food and drinks that Americans like to eat at their wedding ceremonies. At the end of the ceremony, the bride and the groom cut the cake and feed it to each other. This shows that they are one flesh. They also throw rice which is a symbol of blessing and fruitfulness of the marriage.

People have different styles of how to wear clothes especially at wedding ceremonies. The shiny hijab of any color which covers the body of the bride is usually common to see at the Somali wedding ceremonies. Necklaces, bracelets, and rings of gold are also what the Somali brides like to wear at their wedding ceremony. A groom mostly wears a beautiful white kameez and headcraft. In The USA bride wears a white wedding gown which is a symbol associated with innocence, purity, and virginity. The groom wears a suit or tuxedo, especially a black colored one.



Culture and religion are the most important factors that affect the difference between the societies of their wedding ceremonies. Somalia and The USA have different foods and dresses of their wedding ceremonies. Two Different Worlds, One Love

When I first met my wife, I thought marriage in other cities was the same as in Sanliurfa, Turkey. The more I knew her, the more I realized that it was completely different than in Sanliurfa. I know cultures can affect traditions but I never thought that it was going to be so different. I was born in Sanliurfa, which is a city on the east of Turkey, almost near the border with Iraq and Syria. Sanliurfa is a very conservative city. On the other hand, my wife grew up in Portland which is very open-minded culture. In Sanliurfa and Portland marriage culture is extremely different.

First, in Sanliurfa, as a man, dating wasn't permitted. However, nowadays people date in secret or if the parents are modern. In my days, I was not allowed to date. My wife has been living in Portland for 12 years so she has a different culture and she was able to date. When I started talking to her, she didn't know about my customs, traditions or culture. She didn't know I could not date. It was a long distance relationship but for me it was a very serious relationship. In Sanliurfa, most of the families are strict about dating. If you meet a girl it has to be to marry. Usually, the parents find a girl to marry their son. Then the traditional customs start. The family goes to meet the girl and the man for the first time will see the girl. She will make a salty coffee and the family will see the man's attitude by seeing his face while drinking the salty coffee. After that the father of the girl will accept or deny the relationship. On the other hand, the traditions in Portland are completely different from tradition in Sanliurfa. People usually date for months or years, or different people can date until they find the one.

The second step is the engagement. In Sanliurfa the engagement is a big party. It is the step that formalizes the relationship. In my case, I proposed to my now wife after 6 months of knowing her. We made a party in which there was a ceremony. Someone that you admire will start the ceremony by giving advice, and after that we share the rings. The rings are tied together with a red ribbon. Once the rings are in each one's finger the person who gave the advice will cut the red ribbon and we will start the party. In Portland, people usually don't get engaged very fast. It can take month or years to get engaged. Usually, in Portland people move in together and after months or years they start thinking about getting engaged. In Portland, It takes some time to formalize a relationship between boyfriend and girl-friend. There is no time frame or a tradition to follow for people to get engaged.

The final step is marriage. In Sanliurfa, marriage is very important and also a very serious step. It's a commitment that can't be broken. You can be engaged for a maximum of one year. In that year, most of the time parents and the bride plan the wedding. It's the biggest event for girls. It has to be big and extravagant. Usually the father of the bride talks to the groom and requests for a furnished house and some money for his daughter. Sometimes gold is also requested as a gift for the bride to be. For example, my family gave to my wife two gold bracelets as a gift for the wedding. On the other hand, in Portland marriage can come anytime. It all depends on the couple, and if they are committed and want to be married. Sometimes couples can be together for years and not get married. It is unpredictable when couples get married after dating or being engaged for a while.

In conclusion, marriage customs can vary depending on the city, culture and traditions. As for me, it took me less than a year to be married. However, I think that if I had lived longer in Portland I might have done the process of getting married slower just because you get adapted to the culture.

How do Couples Breakup?

A person is born again when he falls in love, that is a fact. Lovers often claim that love is the sweetest thing that has ever happened to them. Love doesn't only make a lover incapable of seeing the faults of the person he adores. It literally makes him incapable of seeing anyone else. Alas, not all supposed lovers truly fall in love. People vary in different aspects such as, the way they think, the way they love and the way they hate things, so it takes time to find the perfect match to fall in love with. On the other hand, some relationships lack chemistry and love. This relationship can be so exhausting emotionally and mentally to the partners that it becomes visible that this relationship is doomed to fail. Ironically, in such toxic relationships both partners suffer equally. In this case, breaking up becomes the best possible solution but even when breaking up, people significantly vary, depending on how far they have gone to with the partner they are breaking up with, how long they have been together and the experiences they have gone through in this relationship. All these factors play a huge role on the way partners act and react to these situations. Partners were found to fall in different criteria when breaking up, some break up with their partner by informing them directly, others ghost away, while the remaining last make their partner take the action.

The first group are the "direct," as they tell their partner directly that they are breaking up with them, this way of breaking up is straight forward. In this case, most partners say, "that they prepared an environment for this act." They also suggest that the partner who is breaking up should remain calm and silent as much as possible. This way of breaking up is known to be effective as it cannot be interpreted in a different way. This way of breaking up is also the most ethical and moral, as a partner is being honest with the person who might be still in love with them, so this could be the last good thing they will do. The second group is the "ghost," as they run away and disappear without notifying their partner. This way of breaking up is mainly preferred by partners who are not ready to confront. In this case, they will make sure their partner won't find them, so they leave no trace behind them. People who ghost usually change their phone numbers, block all their partners' accounts on social media and avoid going to places where their partners might stalk them. Partners who ghost will be expected to live in hiding for a period of time to make sure they don't get caught by their ex-partner. This way of breaking up is less effective as one of the couple's social life will somehow be ruined. Moreover, the situation might get trickier if the dumped partner reported to the police the disappearance of their partner. Finally, this way of breaking up is unethical, as the dumped partner might live in frustration and sadness for missing the partner who dumped them without knowing why.

The third group is the "jerks," as they make their partners break up with them by deliberately ignoring them. Presumably, they were stuck with a partner that they cannot confess their disaffection to. Therefore, they trick their partner into making this decision and thinking it was theirs. This way of breaking up is very cruel and painful, as it requires ignoring a partner for a period of time; they may severely suffer through this process until they give up this relationship and make a decision of breaking up. It also involves lots of meaningless arguments and fights that the partner who wants to end the relationship will come up with. This way of breaking up takes the longest time compared to the other methods, and it is the one that would harm the dumped partner the most.

At the end, partners regardless from which group they are categorized under agree that breaking up from a relationship isn't an easy decision to make. However, taking this hard decision with all its consequences is usually less painful than having a relationship with a person they dislike, or they dislike them. Whether they decided to breakup with their partner directly, break up by ghosting, or by tricking them into breaking up, it will always be better than living a lie they cannot deny.
