## Why am I Here? – PCC Safety Culture

PCC Board Policy B507: PCC's overall commitment to provide a safe, healthful environment for its employees, students & visitors; also addresses environmentally-respectful practices

Environmental Health & Safety (EHS) is authorized to oversee safety and environmental programs and to provide recommendations and guidance on the prevention of injury and environmental damage

## Why am I Here? - Compliance

### **OSHA Safety Committee Requirements**

Management commitment and accountability to safety



- Employee involvement.
- Meeting monthly.
- Trained and know how to apply accident reporting and investigation.
- Agree on a chairperson.
- Serve a minimum of one year, when possible.
- Be compensated at their regular pay rates.
- Trained in hazard identification, conduct inspections.
- Receive safety committee meeting minutes (retain for 3 years).
- Represent the major activities of the organization.
