Thermal System Insulation:

- Boiler insulation
- Pipe insulation
- Furnace insulation
- Water heater insulation

Surfacing Materials:

- Ceiling and wall texture “popcorn” and “orange peel”
- Taping mud compound
- Skim coat
- Sprayed-on insulation
- Sprayed-on fireproofing
- Vermiculite and blown-in insulation
- Stucco and texture
- Plaster
- Acoustical and decorative surfaces
- Joint compounds

Miscellaneous Materials:

- Cement (transite) pipes
- Ceiling tiles
- Cement asbestos board
- Mastics and glues (used on floor or ceiling tiles)
- Fire doors
- Door and cover gaskets
- Sheet vinyl and linoleum
- Vinyl floor tiles (9”x9” floor tiles)
- Ductwork flexible connections
- Electrical wiring insulation
- Niccolite paper under wood roofing shingles
- Built-up roofing
- Roofing felt and patch
- Roofing flashing
- Paints (including silver roof paint)
- Laboratory fume hood ducting and paneling
- Window putty
- Insulation board behind and under wood stoves
- Insulation with older dishwashers and ranges
- Black tar coating on the underside of sinks
- Stove top pads
- Ironing board covers
