### 1910.134 (b) Definitions

**Filtering facepiece (dust mask):** a negative pressure particulate respirator with a filter as an integral part of the facepiece or with the entire facepiece composed of the filtering medium

**Hood:** a respiratory inlet covering that completely covers the head and neck and may also cover portions of the shoulders and torso

**Loose-fitting facepiece:** a respiratory inlet covering that is designed to form a partial seal with the face

**Negative pressure respirator (tight-fitting):** a respirator in which the air pressure inside the facepiece is negative during inhalation with respect to the ambient air pressure outside the respirator

**Positive pressure respirator:** a respirator in which the pressure inside the respiratory inlet covering exceeds the ambient air pressure outside the respirator

**Tight-fitting facepiece:** a respiratory inlet covering that forms a complete seal with the face
