Dear Poppie,

Your last annual audiogram, dated March 15, 2022, shows a hearing level change greater than OR OSHA's permitted level as compared to your baseline audiogram of July 4, 2014. Your audiogram was reviewed by a licensed physician who provided Portland Community College with a report of her findings. You have also received notification of this shift in your hearing by the Environmental Health & Safety Manager.

Because of the noted change in your hearing, Portland Community College needs to ensure that: you are properly wearing effective hearing protection; that you are trained in how to fit and wear the hearing protection; and that you understand the potential effects of noise on your hearing.

The following issues were reviewed with you regarding noise exposure in your work area:

Overexposure to noise can cause noise-inc	luced hearing loss, which can be permanent
Noise affects hearing by damaging the ner	ve cells of the inner ear
Hearing protection is required to protect y	our hearing
