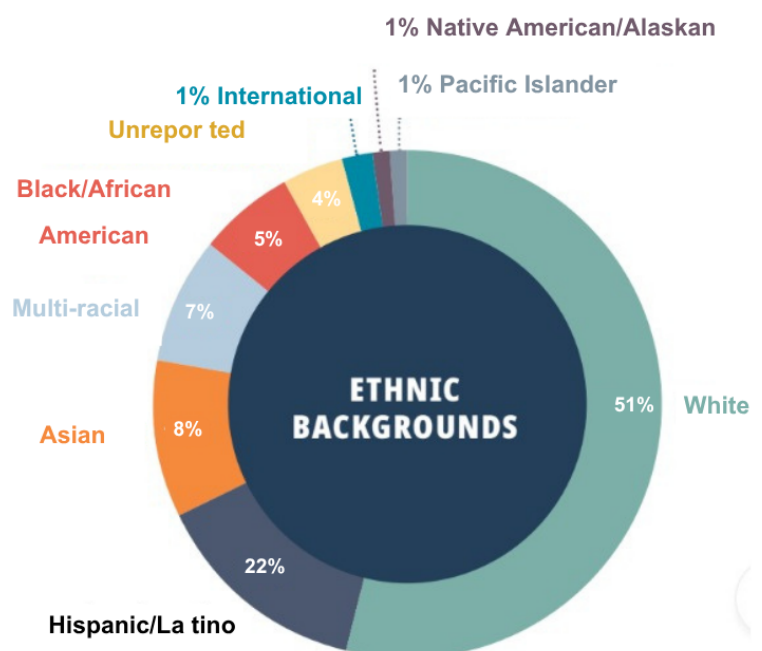

ACADEMIC AND CAREER PATHWAYS

Connecting Systems, Building Skills, Advancing Economic Opportunities

A Career Pathway is a series of connected, high quality education and training programs, that include program advisors to help students to identify their career of choice and a slate of wraparound services support them as they accumulate a series of credentials that enables individuals to secure a job and advance in an industry or occupation. The program has a nearly two-decade track record of successfully fast-tracking Oregonians into family-wage careers and boasts a statewide graduation rate of 89%.

KEY ECONOMIC HIGHLIGHTS

- Impact of PCC's former students currently employed in the regional workforce amounted to \$1.7 billion in added income.
- Students will receive \$1.1 billion in increased earnings over their working lives. This translates to a return of \$3.70 in higher future earnings for every dollar students invest in their education. Students' average annual rate of return is 17.1%.
- For every dollar invested in PCC in 2018-19, people in Oregon will receive \$8.20 in return, for as long as these students remain active in the state workforce.
- PCC is one of the largest employers in the Portland region, employing over 3500 people annually.

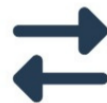
