

About the Performance

Spring term 2005 the Illumination Project's interactive theater performances will focus on the issues of domestic and sexual violence. Domestic and sexual violence impacts *all* members of our community and requires both individual and community-wide responses. The Illumination Project hopes that with these performances you will gain knowledge and skills to help make our community a safer place for everyone.

The Illumination Project performances are based on a style of theater known as *Theater of the Oppressed*. *Theater of the Oppressed* was created by Brazilian theater activist, Augusto Boal. The play will be performed once without interruption. The second time through, audience members have the chance to participate. Yell "STOP!" whenever you see an opportunity to take the place of a character you believe could change the scene to be more positive. Come join the scene on stage and act out your idea!
